

QUAKERTOWN SKC, INC.
RULES & REGULATIONS

- 1 **To qualify to race in the Quakertown Super Kids Classic (SKC) Soap Box Derby, a participant must meet the following qualifications:**
 - a - Be between the ages of 9 & 18 (must not turn 19 before the National Race - 7/25/09)
 - b - Have a permanent physical or mental disability that would disqualify him/her from participating in the All American Soap Box Derby.
 - c - Must submit a completed medical form. This form must be completed by your doctor and must be received no later than Practice Day (NO exceptions!)
- 2 It will be solely the decision of the SKC committee as to the type of car (single or double, hand brake, etc.) to be used by each participant. The determination will be made after careful consideration of the medical form and the participants performance on Practice Day.
- 3 A parent, guardian or designated adult will remain with each participant at all times except during the actual race.
- 4 All areas are secured during the race. Each area has a designated official with the authority to expel anyone, including participants for any action deemed hazardous to themselves or others.
- 5 Winners will be determined by three judges to be selected by the SKC committee.
- 6 We (I) understand that no more than (2) people may remain with the participant at Topside (starting line). These people may be parents, guardians or a designee of the parent or guardian. This person(s) **MUST** be present when the child is placed into the race car. The participant will be returned to Topside at the end of each heat. Designated persons will be at the bottom of the hill to remove the children from the car and return them to Topside.
- 7 If you wish to take your child home immediately after he/she has been eliminated, you may pick your child up at the bottom of the hill but arrangement must be made with officials. If you choose to withdraw your child from the race at any time, **PLEASE notify officials so that brackets can be re-configured.**
- 8 ALL participants must be at the race course (Franklin Ave - Salem, Ohio) at 9 am on Race Day for a driver's meeting and to receive their driver's "license"
- 9 We/I further understand that no child will participate on Practice Day OR Race Day unless **ALL** forms have been completed and turned in. These forms must be on file with Race Officials before participation can be permitted.
- 10 All participants must have a training session before Race Day, if you cannot come to Practice Day, another time will be set-up for your practice.

All Decisions made by the SKC Committee and Judges are Final.
Practice will be held at York Drexler VFW Post 5532 - Washingtonville, Ohio
Race will be held in Salem, Ohio
