

## Quakertown SKC, Inc. Rules and Regulations

1. To qualify to race in the Quakertown Super Kids Classic (SKC) soap box derby:
  - A - a participant must be between the ages of **7 and 19** (can not turn 19 before the National Race - July 20, 2012)
  - B- have a physical or mental handicap that would prevent them from racing in the All American Soap Box Derby. **Weigh no more than 185 lbs\***
  - C - turn in all paperwork required including a medical form completed by your doctor - NO exceptions.
  - D - participate in Practice Day (held on May 12)
2. It will be solely the decision of of he SKC committee as to the type of car assigned to each participant. This will be determined after careful consideration of the medical form and evaluation on Practice Day.
3. A parent, guardian or appointed adult must remain with each participant during the race.
4. All areas are secured during the race. Each area has a designated official with the authority to expel anyone, including participants for any action deemed hazardous to themselves or others.
5. Winners will be determined by a panel of at least (3) judges. Their decision is final.
6. We (I) understand that no more than (2) people may remain with the participant at Topside (starting line.) This person(s) must be present when the child is placed into the race car. Participants will be returned to Topside at the end of each race. A parent, guardian or other designated adult should also be at the finish line to help remove the child from the car if necessary.
7. If you wish to take you child home immediately after he/she is eliminated, you may pick them up at the finish line but please make arrangement with officials so your child receives their trophy, etc. We will have a trophy presentation ceremony sometime after the race.
8. If you child chooses to withdraw from the race at any time for any reason, **PLEASE notify officials so the brackets can be re-configured** . We understand sometimes, a child will decide not to continue, all racers will receive a trophy regardless of finish position or if they finish.
9. All participants must be at the race track on Broadway Avenue in Salem at the designated time on Race Day (time will be determined on Practice Day). A driver's meeting will be held and driver's license will be awarded before the race begins.
10. All forms must be completed and on file with officials before participation can be permitted.
11. All participants must have a training session before Race Day. If your child cannot come to Practice Day, another time will be set up for your practice. All racers will be sent a postcard with an appointment time for Practice Day please make sure to arrive at your designated time with all of your forms. Forms do not need to be turned into until Practice Day BUT you must reserve your spot by April 17th.
